#### Golden Rules of the De-worming Programme

1. Treat all horses in the same pasture together
2. Combine de-worming with regular removal of droppings from pasture
3. Move horses onto 'clean' pasture 24 hours after de-worming
4. If possible alternate grazing on the pasture with different species (eg. Cattle and sheep)
5. Maintain the effectiveness of the de-worming programme using faecal worm egg counts

- A blood test is available that will give a guide as to the tapeworm burden.
- Both the frequency of de-worming and the de-wormer used may change depending on the active worm status of those horses sharing the same pasture. A twice yearly faecal worm egg count is advised to assess the active adult worm population in each horse.
